<b>Subject Knowledge</b>	<p>Continents and oceans Part 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>To name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans</i></li> <li>Explore and find out about the continents and oceans in the world</li> <li>Name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans on a map, atlas, globe</li> <li>Compare locations across the world</li> <li>Know that in the continents there are rainforests, deserts, artic areas, ocean areas and tropical/climate areas</li> </ul>	<p>Comparing locations-Jamaica</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>To understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom, and of a small area in a contrasting non-European country</i></li> <li>Jamaica is an island in the continent of North America</li> <li>The Flag is made up of three colours and how it is only one of two flags in the world that does not have red/white or blue in it</li> <li>The colours of the flag represent different things</li> <li>There are differences in climate, geographical features and human features inc: food production/consumption</li> <li>Kettering is in a developed country, Jamaica is a developing country</li> </ul>	<p>Small Area of the UK – Little Harrodwn</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>NC: To use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.</i></li> <li>Little Harrowden is a town within Northamptonshire</li> <li>Little Harrowden is developed with shops, homes, school and industry</li> <li>Little Harrowden is near a main road (A14) which</li> </ul>	<p>Understanding the UK Part 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>To name, locate and identify characteristics of the 4 countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas</i></li> <li>Castles are located in different counties and countries within Gt Britain</li> <li>Locate a castle in each of the 4 countries</li> </ul>

<b>Subject Discipline</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use atlases and globes to find the five <b>oceans</b> and seven <b>continents</b>.</li> <li>Discuss the location of the continents including how climate affects them.</li> <li>Use the <b>compass points</b> to describe the <b>continents</b> in relation to each other (e.g. Asia is to the east of Europe and to the north of Australia).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use aerial photographs to compare Kettering and Jamaica. What is the same? What is different?</li> <li>Use an atlas to find Jamaica and the UK. Can you give instructions on how to use an atlas?</li> <li></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use google earth and aerial photos to identify features</li> <li>Use maps to recognise major roads</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recap- Find the four <b>countries</b> of the <b>United Kingdom</b> using map skills</li> <li>Compare the <b>human</b> and <b>physical geographical features</b> of the locations of the castles saying how they are similar and different.</li> <li>Use Google Earth to view the castles and their locations.
