What is the same? What is different?</li> <li>Use an atlas to find Jamaica and the UK. Can you give instructions on how to use an atlas?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Use google earth and aerial photos to identify features</li> <li>Use maps to recognise major roads</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Recap- Find the four countries of the United Kingdom using map skills</li> <li>Compare the human and physical geographical features of the locations of the castles saying how they are similar and different.</li> <li>Use Google Earth to view the castles and their locations.
