Headteacher's Review of the Week

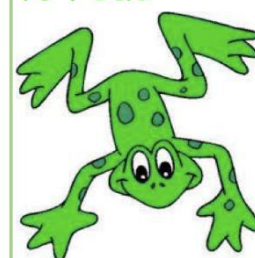
